
Simple activities designed to help parents and/or caregivers participate in, and support, a child's literacy skills and educational goals:



- Easiest: Read the story together. On each page, listen for the Ss sound.
 Point to the letter Ss.
- More Difficult: A sentence begins with a capital letter and ends with a punctuation mark (. ?!) On each page, count how many sentences there are.
- Challenging: Verbs are words that show action, for example, swimming, ran, hopped. On each page, find one action verb.
